Water/Sewer Bills go out on January, April, July, & **October 1st**.

Your October Water/Sewer Bill will be due on October 31st without penalty.

A 2% penalty will be added monthly if not paid by the 31st. We will accept postmarks prior to the 1st of November.

The \$75.00 penalty only applies if your July bill went unpaid.

Overpayments will be returned and you will risk a penalty being applied to your account.

**NO ON-STREET PARKING
§ 144-1. Parking regulations.**

A. Between the first day of December and the first day of April in each year no person shall park any motor vehicle in any street of the Village of Philmont between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. In addition to the other penalties provided by § 144-4 hereof, any car so parked in violation of this subsection shall be subject to removal from such street at the expense of the owner.

The DPW will begin Leaf Pick up once the leaves begin to fall. They have an **ESTIMATED** start date of Mid-October and will continue as long as weather permits. Once you have enough leaves to rake and pile, you may begin to bring them to the edge of your property.

*** LEAVES ONLY ***

Should be raked to the edge of your property as not to impede traffic or block sidewalks.



**Do not mix leaves with any other yard waste.
It will not be picked up.**



Snow and Ice Removal

Duty to keep sidewalks clear. The owner of every lot or premises within the Village of Philmont shall keep the sidewalks adjoining said lot or premises free and clear of all ice and snow for the entire length and width, at least 24 inches, of said sidewalk.

Time limit for removal. Snow and ice shall be removed and cleared away from the sidewalks in the manner specified in §127-7 hereof within 24 hours after each snow or ice shall have fallen or formed on said sidewalks.

Are you a homeowner with a fire hydrant on your property?

Per Village Law, It is your responsibility to clear the hydrant of snow so our Fire Dept. may access it.
