Residents wishing to dispose of unaccepted items and hazardous materials, may dispose of them in person at the Columbia County Transfer Station for a set fee. These items may be taken to the Greenport location, which is located at 51 Newman Road. For applicable fees you may contact them directly at 828-1442.

Please be advised, we have also been notified that Columbia County has canceled their free Hazardous Waste Day due to budget constraints.

The Village of Philmont will be providing **dumpsters for our residents** to dispose of all the “clutter” in our yards, garages, basements and attics. The dumpsters will be located at the DPW garage @ 62 Maple Avenue.

Our DPW staff will be on hand between the hours of 8:00AM – NOON to assist and direct you.

Residents will unload their own items.

No hazardous waste will be accepted.

We will **NOT** be accepting regular household garbage, paints, pesticides, propane tanks, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any appliance containing Freon. **No construction & demolition debris**, tires, upholstered furniture or batteries will be accepted.

TV’s, computers, small appliances, unupholstered furniture, general debris and brush & limbs will be accepted. Scrap metals are also being accepted in a separate area designated for these items.

Proof of residency will be checked!!!

A mask must be worn at all times, all COVID-19 protocol will be enforced.

Mattresses & Box Springs will be \$10 each to dispose of, (A set will be \$20.00). You must pay for this service at the Village office by May 7th to be added to a master list.
