

## Village of Philmont Recycling Protocol

(Same as Columbia County)

**ALL RECYCLING** - Glass, Plastic, Tin, Aluminum, Paper & Cardboard, etc. are picked up on the **1<sup>st</sup>** and **3<sup>rd</sup>** Fridays only.

No recycling is picked up if the month has a 5<sup>th</sup> Friday!

**Items that are not acceptable will be left behind with a violation sticker.**

with proper drainage at the base (a hole in each corner)
