Water/Sewer Bills go out on January, April, **July**, & October 1st.

Your July Water/Sewer Bill will be due on July 31st without penalty.

A 2% penalty will be added monthly if not paid by the 31st. We will accept postmarks prior to the 1st of July.

The \$75.00 penalty only applies if your April bill went unpaid.

Keep the top portion and return the bottom receipt for your records. NO RECEIPT WILL BE MAILED!!

GARBAGE & RECYCLING POLICY

Garbage Bags can be a maximum of 50 pounds

30-gallon capacity – Full Sticker

13-gallon capacity – Half Sticker

NO CONTRACTOR OR LAWN & LEAF BAGS WILL BE PICKED UP REGARDLESS OF WEIGHT

PLASTIC, GLASS & ALUMINUM RECYCLABLES MUST BE CLEAN AND IN A PLASTIC TOTE OR LAUNDRY BASKET WITH DRAINAGE HOLES

YOUR GARBAGE WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF:

* IT DOES NOT HAVE A STICKER

* A 30 GALLON BAG ONLY HAS HALF A STICKER

* IT WEIGHS OVER 50 POUNDS

* IT'S IN A CONTRACTOR/LEAF BAG

*****Cardboard & Paper are not accepted as recyclables if it's wet; it is treated as garbage at that point. Cardboard MUST be broken down and bundled or placed inside 1 intact box. If it is not broken down it WILL NOT BE PICKED UP*****

ALL VILLAGE LANDLORDS

You must have a "Certificate of Occupancy" for all rental units prior to renting! This pertains to all rentals, 2 family, owner-occupied homes included!

All Rental Registry applications need to be completed and returned to the Village office.

July 10TH – Community Day (Parade and Fireworks)

The Parade route has been extended this year for better viewing with less crowding.

Step off will be from Pine Haven at 4pm. The parade route will be upper Main, right onto Maple Avenue, left on Maple Terrace & down Prospect Street ending at 217. There will be NO ON-STREET PARKING on the parade route between 3pm – 6pm (or once parade has ended)

Walk in attendance by the public will be allowed at the Gun Club for the Fireworks, however, a mask must be worn for entry and no cars will be permitted. There will not be a bus shuttle. PARKING: No parking on Railroad or Maple Avenue. For parking, drive down Maple Avenue (past Maple Terrace) and follow the signs. The Philmont Police will be on hand directing traffic. The Philmont Police will also assist those who require handicap access. Please bring your own lawn chairs and blankets.
