ANNUAL BUDGET HEARING – VILLAGE OF PHILMONT DATE: APRIL 10, 2023

Copies of the budget were made available to the public.

**Public Comment: None** 

The proposed tax rate change is 3.52%. The present rate is \$6.390583/1000 of assessed value. The proposed rate is \$6.615697/1000 of assessed value amounting to an overall \$.225114/1000 increase.

The sewer rate will be \$10.50/1000 gallons with a minimum of \$105.00 per unit per quarter, and the water rate will be \$5.50/1000 gallons with a minimum of \$55.00 per unit per quarter. A debt service charge of \$125 a year will be accessed for sewer. This will be broken into quarterly payments for a minimum of 4 years.

Outside water users will have their minimum usage decreased from 20,000 gallons to 10,000 gallons.
