LEAF PICK UP

The DPW will begin leaf pick up once the leaves begin to fall. They have an ESTIMATED start date of Mid-October and will continue as long as weather permits. As soon as you have enough leaves to rake and pile, you may bring them to the edge of your property.

* LEAVES ONLY *

Are to be raked to the edge of your property as not to impede traffic or block sidewalks





<u>DO NOT</u> mix leaves with any other yard waste or they WILL NOT be picked up.

Snow and Ice Removal

§ 127-7. Duty to keep sidewalks clear. The owner of every lot or premises within the Village of Philmont shall keep the sidewalks adjoining said lot or premises free and clear of all ice and snow for the entire length and width, at least 24 inches, of said sidewalk.

§ 127-8. Time limit for removal. Snow and ice shall be removed and cleared away from the sidewalks in the manner specified in §127-7 hereof within 24 hours after each snow or ice shall have fallen or formed on said sidewalks. § 127-9. Placing ice or snow on plowed street prohibited. No person shall throw or place, by any means, any snow or ice on any portion of any Village Street or thoroughfare which has been plowed or shoveled out for the purpose of allowing the passage of traffic. On any lot or premises where there is no room to dispose of snow or ice, snow and ice may be piled at the edge of the sidewalk again, leaving sufficient space for pedestrian traffic as outlined in § 127-7 above. **MOTION** to charge violators of the snow shoveling law (Sec. 127-7 & 127-8) a rate of \$2.00 per lineal foot of sidewalk, to be relevied on property owners' taxes upon nonpayment was made January 13, 2020.

Are you a homeowner with a fire hydrant on your property?

Per Village Law, it is your responsibility to clear the hydrant of snow so that the Fire Company may access it.

NO ON-STREET PARKING

§ 144-1. Parking regulations. A. Between the first day of December and the first day of April in each year no person shall park any motor vehicle in any street of the Village of Philmont between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. In addition to the other penalties provided by § 144-4 hereof, any car so parked in violation of this subsection shall be subject to removal from such street at the expense of the owner.

Overnight parking is available at Memorial Field on Church Street & in the Community Lot on Canal Street. Vehicles must be moved at 6am to allow for plowing by our DPW.

SUMP PUMP CONNECTIONS

It is **ILLEGAL** to have your sump pump connected to the sewer discharge in your home. If there is a question regarding proper installation, you may call the sewer plant to request an inspection at no charge. 672-7640

GARBAGE REMINDER

§ 123-18. Placement of containers for collection.

A. Containers of garbage and refuse shall be set out for collection by the occupant of premises contiguous to a street along which such collection is made, at the side of such street. B. Such containers shall be set out not earlier than 7:00 p.m. of the day preceding, nor later than 7:00 a.m. of collection day. Emptied containers shall be removed from the alley side or curb line within a reasonable time following such emptying, and in no event later than 6:00 p.m. of collection day

Failure to follow Village Law pertaining to garbage protocol may result in a fine

RENTAL REGISTRY

Please remember to return the Rental Property Registration application to the Village office. The Registration fee is \$50 per property and is renewable annually. Each apartment requires an inspection as well, please complete the tenancy occupancy form and \$20 per unit.
