The proposed tax rate change is 0%. The present rate is \$6.615697/1000 of assessed value.
The sewer rate will be $$10.50/1000$ gallons with a minimum of $$105.00$ per unit per quarter, and the water rate will be $$6.50/1000$ gallons with a minimum of $$65.00$ per unit per quarter.
